Thank you for all your continuing support of the Program, which is needed now more than ever.

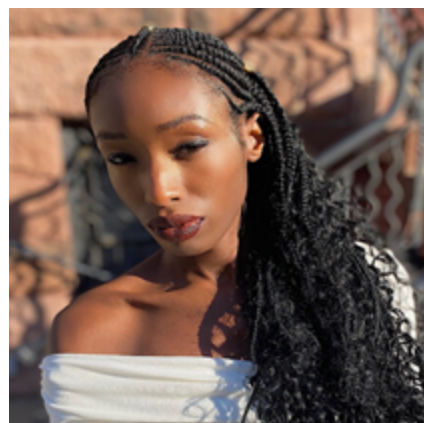
